



Food supplement of Devil's Claw and Meadowsweet, promotes the physiological well-being of the skeletal system.

DESCRIPTION

Harpagophytum is a perennial plant belonging to the Pedaliaceae family.

It has been used since ancient times due to its broad spectrum of actions. It has analgesic and anti-inflammatory properties and is often associated with the cure of back pain and headaches. The harpagosides contained in its root show great analgesic qualities against tendonitis, osteoarthritis and rheumatoid arthritis. Its analgesic and anti-inflammatory properties have been demonstrated by studies carried out with laboratory guinea pigs, where it is shown how the analgesic effect is present in peripheral areas with respect to the central part, while in vitro studies have shown how the action of Harpagophytum does not influence the production of prostaglandins, the molecules responsible for pain, as it does not interfere with cyclooxygenases, that is, the category of enzymes that enables their formation.

Its anti-inflammatory effect, on the other hand, has been determined through preclinical pharmacology studies, which have shown that this action depends on the inhibition of lipoxygenases, a series of enzymes that are responsible for synthesizing compounds called leukotrienes.

In light of the proposed studies, the German European Commission has indicated that Harpagophytum procumbens DC represents an optimal treatment for dyspepsia, anorexia and degenerative pathologies of the muscular and skeletal system. Meadowsweet is a plant belonging to the Rosaceae family and its active ingredients are mainly extracted from the flowering tops.

Its phytochemicals are used in the presence of joint pain, fever and flu. Indeed, its composition contains various types of substances such as: polyphenols, salicylic glycosides (which also form compounds called spireins), essential oils, vitamins, gallic tannins and coumarins. Meadowsweet has soothing, antipyretic and anti-inflammatory properties, mainly derived from the action of the salicylates present, which inhibit the synthesis of prostaglandins, responsible for pain and tissue damage. The presence of mucilage also protects the gastric mucosa, preventing side effects such as heartburn and cramps, sometimes caused by drug therapy. However, since salicylates are the active ingredient of aspirin, the plant is not recommended in cases of allergy or hypersensitivity to the drug. The combined treatment with Meadowsweet and Devil's Claw allows for the development of natural gastro-resistance. Thanks to Meadowsweet, in fact, the gastric juices normally present in the digestive tract react with the active ingredients contained in it and produce salicylates more quickly.

Ingredients

Water, alcohol, Devil's Claw (*Harpagophytum procumbens* DC.) rhizome, Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria* Max.) tops, honey, mixture of natural flavours.

Instructions for use


Adults (Recommended dosage for subjects of normal weight) 25 drops three times a day. Dilute in water.

Up to 12 years (Recommended dosage for subjects of normal weight) 10 drops three times a day. Dilute in water.

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
