



*Food supplement of Senna and Aloe that promote physiological and normal intestinal transit.*

### DESCRIPTION

#### Ingredients

Extracts and Powders of: Senna (*Cassia senna L.*) leaves, Aloe (*Aloe vera L.*) leaf juice, Fennel (*Foeniculum vulgare Mill.*) fruits, Anise (*Pimpinella anisum L.*) fruits, Chamomile (*Matricaria chamomilla L.*) flowers, Gum arabic, Rhubarb (*Rheum officinale Baill.*) rhizome, Licorice (*Glycyrrhiza glabra L.*) rhizome, Cream of tartar, Wild rose (*Rosa canina L.*) fruits is titrated at 70% in Vit.C.

The leaves of the species *Cassia alexandrina*, commonly and generically referred to as Senna, have laxative properties that have been known for centuries.

As with aloe, the purgative action is determined by the anthracene derivatives and in particular by the anthraquinones combined in the form of glucosides.

The main components of Aloe are glycosides that, when metabolized into aglycones, act by stimulating colon motility: the hemodin released is transformed by bacteria into antron, which increases peristalsis and mucus production.

Fennel seeds have always been used in dyspeptic disorders, bloating and gastrointestinal spasms. Combined with anthraquinone laxatives, they correct the atony that often occurs with the use of such preparations.

Anise seeds can be considered valid regulators of digestive processes and effective carminatives.

The stimulating action of green anise on peristalsis, in cases of intestinal atony, together with its antispastic action, justify its application in dyspepsia, gastrointestinal spasms and meteorism.

Chamomile has always been known as a plant with antispasmodic activities, particularly indicated for calming painful symptoms such as intestinal colic.

Due to the presence of tannins, rhubarb in high doses becomes an excellent laxative. Its action is located at the level of the large intestine, where it determines the inhibition of water reabsorption and an increase in intestinal peristalsis.

Licorice has a high antispasmodic action related to the presence of flavonoids. This activity is used in the formulation of laxative preparations, in association with anthroquinone drugs, since it limits the side effects. Its use is interesting in aerophagia and meteorism.

Rosa canina has a mild laxative and diuretic action related to the content of pectins and organic acids. The tincture also contains substances

with anti-inflammatory action to be used, for example, in spastic colitis and gastroenteritis.
