



Centella Food Supplement, promotes the functionality of the microcirculation of heavy legs.

DESCRIPTION

Centella asiatica grows in the warm and humid virgin forests of Madagascar, India, Japan and China, and is also widespread in other warm countries. The leaves stimulate blood flow, which is why it is traditionally used for edema, hemorrhoids, heaviness of ligaments, varicose veins and vascular disease.

An Indian legend tells that a wounded tiger would rub its wound against this plant to speed up its healing. In fact, due to its healing action in powder form, it is used externally in dermatology for wounds. In India and Madagascar, centella asiatica is used against leprosy, due to its soothing effects. Centella is slightly laxative. It strengthens brain functions and can be used preventively against the aging process.

The glucosides, triterpene esters of asiaticosides and madercasiosides, are responsible for the effects of Centella. These components have been shown to stimulate, in vitro, the production of human collagen, a protein involved in wound healing.

Ingredients: Water, alcohol, Centella (Centella asiatica L.) tops 20%, honey.
