



Butcher's broom dietary supplement, promotes the functionality of the hemorrhoidal plexus.

DESCRIPTION

The evergreen butcher's broom is widespread in Ticino and in the Mediterranean areas along dry and steep slopes. The knobby rhizome is dug up in autumn and dried in the sun. Its active ingredients have anti-inflammatory, vasodilatory, haemostatic, antipyretic and diuretic effects. Regular intake of butcher's broom stabilises the texture of capillaries. Venous conditions are the main field of application for butcher's broom, which has an even greater influence on vascular tension than horse chestnut.

It also reduces the permeability of the capillary membrane, with the consequent improvement of edema. The venous remedy also reduces the swelling of inflamed hemorrhoids. It contains saponins (ruscogenins and neoruscogenins) that have anti-inflammatory activity at the level of the connective tissue and act on the musculature of the vessels regulating their connectivity, finally tannins, sterols, flavonoids and mineral salts.

Ingredients: Water, alcohol, Butcher's broom (*Ruscus aculeatus* L.) root 20%, honey.
