



Tansy Food Supplement, promotes digestive function.

DESCRIPTION

Native to Asia Minor, it is common in uncultivated, sunny places throughout temperate Europe and the United States.

The flowers and aerial parts of the plant are used.

It has an antiallergic action, having been shown that the extract of Tansy causes a dose-dependent inhibition of the secretion of histamine by peritoneal mast cells in laboratory rats in vitro, when stimulated with anti IgE serum.

Contains essential oil, tanacetin, turion, camphor, borneol, alcohols and resin.

As a side effect, it can cause allergic skin reactions, even generalized, but which quickly disappear when treatment is stopped. Ulcerative lesions have been described in the mucosa of the oral cavity, which are also rapidly reversible when the doses are stopped.

Its use is not recommended during pregnancy, during breastfeeding and in children under 10 years of age.

Ingredients: Water, alcohol, Tansy (*Tanacetum vulgare* L.) tops 20%, honey.
