DESCRIPTION

Vitamin B6 can be found in three different forms: pyridoxine, pyridoxamine and pyridoxal, all of which are normally present in foods. Vitamin B6 must first be converted into the active compound pyridoxal-5-phosphate (P5P) in the liver.

This vitamin plays an important role in various body functions such as: metabolism at the cellular level, muscle growth and repair, mood regulation, sleep regulation and is very popular among women as a premenstrual supplement.

By consuming vitamin B6 in the active form of P5P, conversion is no longer necessary, meaning it is ready to be used by the body.

This product provides 20 mg of P5P per tablet.

Precautions

This product is not recommended for pregnant or breastfeeding women. The dose of vitamin B6 in this product is 20 mg/day, and it should not be consumed for more than 6 months, since its consumption for longer periods may cause peripheral neuropathy in some individuals, the symptoms of which are: tingling, numbness, paresthesia and pain in the extremities. If any of these symptoms appear, stop taking the product and consult your doctor.

Instructions for use:

- For ages 15 years and older. Take 1 tablet daily with a meal.
- Do not exceed the expressly recommended daily dose.
