DESCRIPTION

What is basil and what is it used for?

Basil or scientifically Ocimum basilicum is a herbaceous plant that reaches between thirty and one hundred and thirty meters in height, has oval, serrated leaves with a silky texture. The flowers are tubular, white or purple.

What part of Basil?

The flowering top is used.

What are the active ingredients of basil?


- Essential oil, of variable composition depending on the origin
- Mediterranean origin: linalool predominates (45-62%).
- Origin Madagascar, Réunion Island, Comoros Islands: contains mainly estragole or methyl cavicol (65-65%), together with small amounts of cineol, fenchol, linalool and methyl-eugenol;
- Tropical areas predominate (E)-methyl cinnamate or methyl-eugenol.
- Flavonoids: xanthomicrol, quercetin heterosides and kempferol.
- Others: tannins, caffeic acid, esculoside.

What properties does basil have?

- Digestive and appetizer.
- Carminative.
- Diuretic.
- galactogenic.
- Astringent.
- Analgesic and anti-inflammatory
