There are few known unwanted side effects of Solgar Wild Oregano Oil, at the recommended dosage. Some people develop gastrointestinal upset. Topical application of wild oregano essential oil to the skin can cause localized dermatitis. Rarely, a systemic allergic reaction (anaphylaxis) may occur due to ingestion of oregano.

Does Solgar Wild Oregano Oil have any contraindications?

Solgar's Wild Oregano Oil is contraindicated in pregnancy, since it can have an abortifacient and uterine stimulating effect.

On the other hand, there is not enough information on the safety of the use of Oregano Oil during lactation, so its use is not recommended.

Can Solgar Wild Oregano Oil interact with any medications?

Solgar's Wild Oregano Oil can increase the risk of bleeding, therefore, it is contraindicated when taking anticoagulants.
